


Summary of timetable changes

(1)(2)**Saturday** - The 2300 Oxford to London Paddington will start from Didcot Parkway at 2351 and run 30-35 minutes later throughout. Sunday - All day, many High Speed services to / from London Paddington will be retimed, in some cases, departing EARLIER from 12 London Paddington. Most fast services between London Paddington and Oxford will not run, but will be partly replaced by additional 34 trains between Didcot Parkway, Radley and Oxford. Most local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and (5) 17 Didcot Parkway will only run between Reading and Didcot Parkway. Fast services between London Paddington and Swindon 22 (sometimes beyond) will call additionally at Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling. **Tuesday to Thursday** - As a consequence of some trains to / from London Paddington being diverted via Swindon, most local trains (4)(9) between Swindon / Chippenham and Westbury via Melksham will be replaced by buses between Chippenham and Westbury. Some other trains running through Westbury will also be revised. A few trains will either not run at all, or will only run for part of their journey. (24) 36 Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling. **Saturday** - The 1923 Portsmouth Harbour to Cardiff Central will terminate at Newport. An alternative rail connection, operated by (6) Transport for Wales, will be available from Newport to Cardiff Central. Monday from approximately 2145 until end of service - Buses will replace trains between Newbury and Bedwyn. Tuesday to Thursday - All day on all three days, buses will replace trains between Newbury and Bedwyn. Some trains between $(\mathbf{8})\mathbf{8}$ London Paddington, Reading and Newbury will be retimed and a few trains will not run. Long-distance High Speed services that would normally run via Newbury will also be diverted - see next item. **Tuesday to Friday** - The 0532 Bedwyn to London Paddington will not run. Passengers should travel on the next available service. Tuesday to Thursday - All day on all three days, long-distance High Speed services between London Paddington and the West of England will be diverted between Reading and Taunton to run via Bristol Temple Meads. Most trains will depart EARLIER from 89 London Paddington and Reading. Trains that would normally call at Newbury, Hungerford and Pewsey will be diverted between Reading and Westbury to run via Swindon. A few trains will not run at all. Trains will continue to run between London Paddington, 10 Reading and Newbury, with replacement buses between Newbury and Hungerford / Bedwyn. Pewsey will be served by replacement buses to / from Swindon. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling. **Tuesday to Thursday** - As a consequence of trains to / from London Paddington being diverted via alternative routes between (11)(12)Reading and Swindon / Taunton, some trains will be subject to retiming, and a few trains will either not run at all, or will only run for (13) (43) part of their journey. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling. Saturday from approximately 2245 until end of service - Buses will replace trains between Didcot Parkway and Oxford. (17)Sunday - The 0754 Oxford to London Paddington will start from Didcot Parkway. Passengers travelling from Oxford should use the next available service.

17 18 19	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Great Malvern and Hereford. On Saturday only , a few GWR trains to / from Great Malvern will not run west of Worcester Shrub Hill and the 0828 Worcester Foregate Street to London Paddington will not run at all. Passengers should travel on alternative services (including West Midlands Railway services where appropriate).
20 37	Monday to Thursday - The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will be diverted to run non-stop from Swindon to, and terminate at, Gloucester. A replacement bus will serve intermediate stations via Stroud.
24 25	Sunday - The 1740 Cardiff Central to Portsmouth Harbour will terminate at Westbury. Passengers should travel on an alternative earlier or later service.
26 26	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Fareham and Portsmouth & Southsea / Portsmouth Harbour. In addition: Saturday - The 0540 Portsmouth & Southsea to Bristol Temple Meads will start from Fareham;
	Sunday - The 1934 Bristol Temple Meads to Portsmouth Harbour will terminate at Southampton Central; Monday - The 0450 Fratton to Bristol Temple Meads will start from Southampton Central and the 0601 Portsmouth Harbour to Cardiff Central will start from Fareham.
29	Sunday - Trains will be reduced to hourly and will run between Guildford, Redhill and Gatwick Airport only. Replacement buses will run between Reading and Guildford.
29	Friday - The 2333 Reading to Gatwick Airport will terminate at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Gatwick Airport.
40	Tuesday to Thursday - As a consequence of trains to / from London Paddington being diverted via alternative routes between Reading and Taunton, a few trains between London Paddington and Weston-super-Mare will not run between Bristol Temple Meads and Weston-super-Mare. Passengers should use alternative services.
49	Monday to Friday - All week, GWR trains will not run between Swansea and Carmarthen. Replacement buses, provided by Transport for Wales, will run instead, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.
B	Saturday - The 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington will not call at Burnham and Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
P	Sunday from approximately 0845 until 2215 - trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
