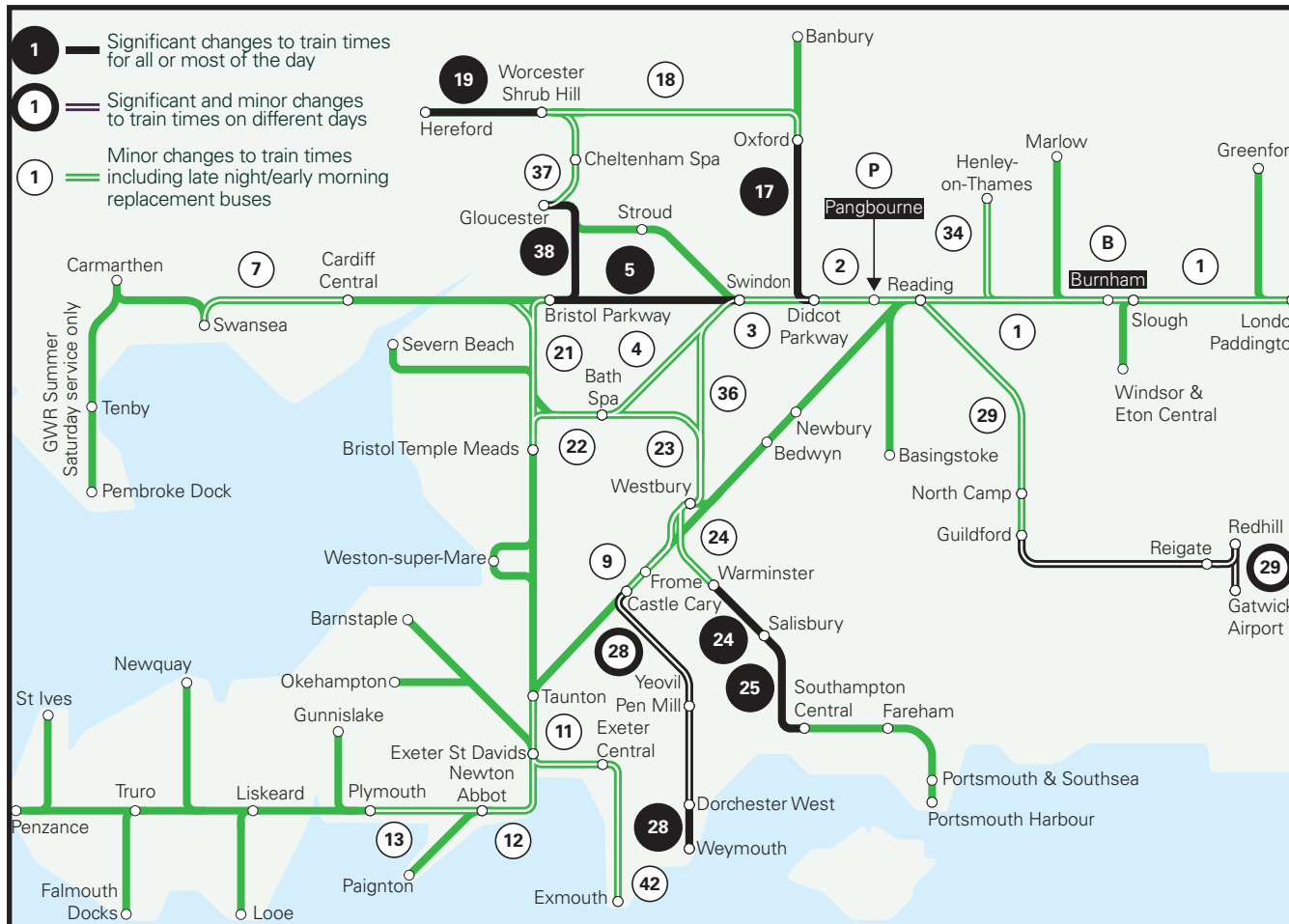


Summary of timetable changes

① **Saturday** - All day, local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will generally only run hourly between London Paddington and Reading.

Sunday - All day, many High Speed services to / from London Paddington will be retimed, in some cases departing EARLIER from London Paddington. Most fast services between London Paddington and Oxford will not run, but will be partly replaced by additional trains between Didcot Parkway, Radley and Oxford. Most local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will only run between Reading and Didcot Parkway. Fast services between London Paddington and Swindon (sometimes beyond) will be retimed and will call additionally at Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

From approximately 1115 on Saturday and all day Sunday - Trains between London Paddington / Reading and South Wales will be diverted between Swindon and Bristol Parkway via an alternative route, extending journey times. Most trains FROM London Paddington towards South Wales will depart EARLIER from London Paddington, Reading, (Didcot Parkway) and Swindon. Most trains running between London Paddington and Swindon will be retimed and a few trains will not run at all. On Sunday, some trains will call additionally at Didcot Parkway. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

Sunday - The 2045 (departing 2007) and 2145 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted between Cardiff Central and Bridgend, extending journey times by approximately 25 minutes.

⑦ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2048, 2148 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Cardiff Central and will arrive up to 25 minutes later at Bridgend and beyond.

Monday to Friday - The 0346 Swansea to London Paddington will depart EARLIER at 0338 and will run slightly earlier as far as Cardiff Central.

⑨ **Saturday** - The 2312 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will terminate at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Frome.

⑨ **Tuesday** - The 2130 Cardiff Central to Frome and the 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will both terminate at Westbury. Replacement buses will run from Westbury to Frome.

Sunday until approximately 1030 - The 0810 Warminster to Swindon and the 0912 Swindon to Westbury will be replaced by buses to / from Chippenham, in some cases, running EARLIER than usual. Alternative rail connections will be available between Chippenham and Swindon. The 0839 Westbury to Bristol Temple Meads will depart at 0908 and run later throughout.

The 0801 Weymouth to Cardiff Central will start from Yeovil Pen Mill and the 1753 Weymouth to Bristol Temple Meads will start from Westbury - no replacement transport will be provided.

Sunday - A few trains will be slightly retimed between Westbury / Bath Spa and Bristol Temple Meads.

Monday to Friday - The 1610 Gloucester to Weymouth will terminate at Frome and the 0733 Weymouth to Gloucester will start from Westbury and run much EARLIER as far as Bristol Temple Meads. No replacement transport will be provided between Westbury / Frome and Weymouth.

⑬ **Monday and Tuesday** - The 2104 London Paddington to Plymouth will run later from Totnes to Plymouth. The 2145 Penzance to London Paddington will run later from Totnes to Taunton.

- 18 19** **Saturday and Sunday** - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Worcester Shrub Hill / Worcester Foregate Street and Great Malvern / Hereford. A few trains starting from Worcester Shrub Hill towards Oxford and London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER than usual.

- 21 37** **38** **From approximately 1200 on Saturday and all day Sunday** - buses will replace trains between Bristol Parkway and Gloucester. A few early morning / late evening buses will be extended to run from / to Bristol Temple Meads and Filton Abbey Wood. In addition:
Saturday - The 0742 Bristol Temple Meads to Worcester Foregate Street will run later from Gloucester and terminate at Worcester Shrub Hill. The 1038 Bristol Temple Meads to Worcester Foregate Street will terminate at Gloucester and the 0635 Great Malvern to Bristol Temple Meads & 0952 Worcester Foregate Street to Bristol Temple Meads will start from Worcester Shrub Hill.
Sunday - The 0938 Bristol Temple Meads to Worcester Shrub Hill will start from Bristol Parkway and will run non-stop to Gloucester via an alternative route. The 2157 Worcester Shrub Hill to Bristol Temple Meads will run non-stop from Gloucester to Bristol Parkway via an alternative route.

- 24 25** **Saturday** - All day, buses will replace trains between Salisbury and Southampton Central. The 0705 Westbury to Southampton Central will not run and the 0830 Southampton Central to Bristol Temple Meads will start from Salisbury.
Sunday - All day, trains between Cardiff Central and Portsmouth Harbour will be replaced by buses between Warminster, Salisbury and Southampton Central. Other trains running between Bristol Temple Meads, Westbury and Salisbury will not run between either Westbury or Warminster and Salisbury, with no replacement transport provided.
All weekend, passengers travelling to / from Romsey will need to use alternative replacement buses between Salisbury and Southampton Central operated by SWR.

- 28** **Sunday** - All day, trains to / from Weymouth will terminate at / start from Dorchester West. Replacement buses will run between Yeovil Pen Mill, Upwey and Weymouth. Passengers travelling between other intermediate stations from Thornford to Maiden Newton and Upwey / Weymouth will need to use alternative replacement buses, operated by SWR, running between Dorchester South and Weymouth. Valid GWR tickets will be accepted on these buses.
Monday to Friday - All week, buses will replace trains between Castle Cary, Yeovil Pen Mill and all stations to / from Weymouth.

- 29** **Saturday and Sunday** - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Guildford, Redhill and Gatwick Airport. A few trains between Reading and Guildford will either not run at all, or will be retimed. **On Saturday**, passengers travelling between intermediate stations from Shalford to Reigate and Gatwick Airport will need to change at Redhill and use other operators' rail services to travel to / from Gatwick Airport (valid GWR tickets will be accepted). **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

- 29** **Monday** - The 0445 Redhill to Gatwick Airport will not run and the 0511 Gatwick Airport to Reading will start from Redhill. Passengers should use other operators' services to travel to / from Gatwick Airport, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.
Friday - The 2333 Reading to Gatwick Airport will terminate at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Gatwick Airport.

- 34** **Tuesday to Friday** - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will terminate at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.

③④ **Tuesday to Friday** - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will terminate at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.

④② The 2340 (**Monday to Wednesday**) Exeter St Davids to Exmouth and the 0019 (**Tuesday to Thursday**) Exmouth to Exeter St Davids will not run and will be replaced by buses.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:

Saturday - 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading;

③ **Tuesday to Friday** - 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington;

In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: Sunday - 0638 London Paddington to Reading, 0620 & 0742 Reading to London Paddington, 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington.

Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

The following GWR trains will not call at Pangbourne:

③ **Monday to Wednesday:** 2236 & 2334 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2324 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

Tuesday to Thursday - 0346 Oxford to Reading (no replacement transport provided);

Friday - 2334 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway;

Unless otherwise stated, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
