

12 34 1722	Sunday - All day, many High Speed services to / from London Paddington will be retimed, in some cases departing EARLIER from London Paddington. Most fast services between London Paddington and Oxford will not run, but will be partly replaced by additional trains between Didcot Parkway, Radley and Oxford. Most local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will only run between Reading and Didcot Parkway. Fast services between London Paddington and Swindon (sometimes beyond) will be retimed and will call additionally at Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford.
	Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling
23 422	Sunday - The 2300 & 2333 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Reading to run non-stop to Bath Spa, not calling at Didcot Parkway, Swindon or Chippenham. Passengers for Didcot Parkway should use an alternative local service from Reading. Replacement buses will run from Reading to Swindon and Chippenham.
	Saturday - The 0828 Worcester Foregate Street to London Paddington will not run. Passengers should travel on an earlier or later service.
2 17	Sunday - The 1450 London Paddington to Great Malvern will terminate at Worcester Shrub Hill. Passengers travelling beyond
18	Worcester Shrub Hill should travel on an alternative service.
	Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service - Buses will replace trains between Oxford and Worcester Shrub Hill.
67	Wednesday and Thursday - The 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will run approximately 10 minutes later from Newport onwards.
7	Sunday - The 0755 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Replacement buses will run EARLIER from Swansea and intermediate stations to Cardiff Central.
(8)	 Sunday - The 0806 Reading to Newbury will be replaced by a bus, departing EARLIER than usual. The 0834 Reading to Bedwyn will start from Newbury. The 0751 (departing 0747) London Paddington to Penzance will be diverted after Reading to run non-stop to Westbury and will not call at Newbury and Pewsey. The 0851 (departing 0843) London Paddington to Penzance will depart EARLIER from Reading and will call additionally at Newbury and Pewsey. Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service each evening - Buses will replace trains between Reading,
	Newbury and Bedwyn. A few other trains will be retimed, in some cases, EARLIER than usual.
	Tuesday to Friday - The 0532 Bedwyn to London Paddington will not run. Passengers should travel on the next available service.
928	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Castle Cary, Yeovil Pen Mill and all stations to / from Weymouth. A few other trains will not run between either Westbury or Frome and Castle Cary.

Saturday 28 September to Friday 4 October 2024

(1) (40)	 Monday, Tuesday and Thursday from approximately 2200 until end of service each evening - Trains between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare, Taunton and Exeter St Davids will either be diverted to run non-stop between Bristol Temple Meads and Taunton, or will be replaced by buses for all or part of their journey. Wednesday - The 2244 Taunton to Bristol Temple Meads and the 1915 Penzance to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted to run non-stop from Taunton to Bristol Temple Meads. Replacement buses will serve intermediate stations via Weston-super-Mare.
20 37	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Gloucester, Cheltenham Spa and Worcester Shrub Hill / Worcester Foregate Street. A few trains will not run at all. Most trains from London Paddington / Swindon to Gloucester will run a few minutes later from Stonehouse to Gloucester. Most trains from Gloucester to Swindon / London Paddington will depart a few minutes EARLIER from Gloucester.
21	Monday to Thursday - The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will not call at Stapleton Road or Lawrence Hill. A replacement bus, running from Filton Abbey Wood to Bristol Temple Meads, will serve these stations.
22 23	Monday, Tuesday and Thursday - The 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury will depart at 2308 and run slightly later throughout.
24	Saturday - The 0705 Westbury to Southampton Central will depart at 0820 and will terminate at Salisbury. The 0830 Southampton Central to Bristol Temple Meads will start from Westbury. Sunday - The 1740 Cardiff Central to Portsmouth Harbour and the 1934 Bristol Temple Meads to Portsmouth Harbour will terminate at Westbury.
25 26	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains between Cardiff Central / Bristol Temple Meads and Portsmouth Harbour will be diverted between Romsey and Fareham, not calling at Southampton Central, but will mostly call additionally at Chandlers Ford and Eastleigh. Replacement buses will run between Southampton Central and Eastleigh.
29	Saturday and Sunday - All day, trains will run between Reading and Guildford only. Replacement buses will run between Guildford and Redhill / Gatwick Airport. A few trains will not run at all.
29	 Monday to Thursday - The 2322 Gatwick Airport to Reading will terminate at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Reading. Tuesday to Friday - The 0432 Reading to Gatwick Airport and 0500 Reading to Redhill will start from Guildford. Replacement buses will run EARLIER from Reading to Guildford, but not calling at every station. The 0531 Reading to Gatwick Airport will depart slightly EARLIER and call at all stations from Wokingham to Ash. Friday - The 2022 Reading to Shalford will not run. The 2054 Reading to Gatwick Airport will call additionally at Crowthorne, Sandhurst, Farnborough North, Ash and Shalford. The 2130 Shalford to Reading will not run. Passengers should use an alternative earlier or later service.

Saturday 28 September to Friday 4 October 2024

30	Sunday - The 0737 & 0837 Reading to Basingstoke and the 0806 Basingstoke to Reading will not run. Replacement buses will run instead, in some cases departing EARLIER than usual. Buses will not call at Reading West, and passengers should use alternative, later services.
33	Sunday - The 0007 Marlow to Maidenhead will terminate at Bourne End. A replacement bus will run from Bourne End to Maidenhead
49	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Swansea, Llanelli and Carmarthen. Some buses will be operated by Transport for Wales, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.
B	 The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow: Saturday - 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington; Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading; Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow. The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: Sunday - 0620 Reading to London Paddington, 0638 London Paddington to Reading, 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.
P	The following GWR trains will not call at Pangbourne: Sunday: 0738, 2233 & 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 0818 & 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
